

By entering this show you are agreeing to NECWPCA RULES OF ENTRY

- 1. All animals in affiliated open classes to be registered in the appropriate studbook. All registration numbers must be stated on the entry form.
- 2. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry
- 3. The committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any class/classes
- 4. On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal
- 5. All Colts and Stallions over 2 years old must correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. They must be licensed as per their appropriate breed society.
- 6. All trophies remain the property of the NECWPCA, and winners are responsible for their safe return
- 7. The judge's decision is FINAL
- 8. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground
- 9. Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound. If in the opinion of the judge, any animal is considered unsound, the exhibitor may withdraw the exhibit from the class or ask for a vet to examine the animal. If no vet is available, the judge's decision is final. (All vet's fees paid by exhibitor)
- 10. Objections must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within thirty minutes of the disputed event. A deposit of £30 must be paid, which will be returned if the objection is upheld. The decision of the committee is FINAL
- 11. The committee will deal with all disputes relating to the Association and their decision being final and binding without any appeal to law
- 12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE
- 13. All foals must be three weeks old or over on the day of the show
- 14. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the approved BSI standard VG1 or PAS015 2011 should be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by children under 14 years whilst in the ring.
- 15. Policy for closing rings:
- 16. **IN HAND** When the last pony/cob has done its individual trot round.
- 17. RIDDEN When the class goes into trot
- 18. Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximate, please have all exhibits forward in good time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the committee excepts no responsibility should they clash
- The Association, committee, assistants or stewards shall in no way be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused
- 20. Annual Equine Flu Vaccinations must be up to date. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee.
- 21. All ridden ponies must be four years old & over
- 22. Ridden Stallions Sections A & B and small breed to be ridden by children 12 years old & over. Sections C & D and large breed to be ridden by children 14 years old & over.
- 23. Ridden Stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker. It is recommended that In Hand Stallions also display a bridle marker.
- 24. No entry fee will be refunded unless a Veterinary Certificate is produced
- 25. Dogs must be always kept on the lead
- 26. All exhibitors must be conversant with the current rules set by the WPCS, The National Welsh Championship Show, NPS, TSR, EQUIFEST, CHAPS, VHS & NECWPCA
- 27. No persons are allowed in the horse walkways/ring entrance unless riding or leading a Horse/Pony
- 28. Dogs must be on a lead at all times and Push chairs, prams and wheelchairs are discouraged near Horse/Pony

WPCS rule 9.7.2 Animals 3 years and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes, Long Hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle may NOT be trimmed.

Class 40 – Welsh A or B First Ridden – Mare of Gelding 4 years or over not exceeding 128cms. The rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before Jan 1st in the current year. Ponies to be shown in any suitable bridle. Class 41 – Welsh A or B 4 years old and over – Rider any age (Stallions not to be ridden by any competitor under the age of 12)

Class 42 – Welsh C or D 4 years old and over – Rider any age (Stallions under 13'2hh not to be ridden by any competitor under the age of 12 and stallions over 13'2hh not to be ridden by any competitor under the age of 14. Class 43 – Welsh Part Bred Ridden Horse or Pony – Rider of any age (Stallions under 13'2hh not to be ridden by any competitor under the aged of 12 and stallions over 13'2hh not to be ridden by any competitor under the age of 14)
